This brief Guide/Tutorial is designed to help you more efficiently navigate the biomarkerEDU.com website. As with all Learning Management Systems (LMS), certain steps must be performed in a specific order. This guide will walk you through the steps to complete the Evaluation and Request for Credit for your participation in a “Live / Virtual Live” event.

The steps begin once you have logged in to your account. If you have not created an account or one has not been created for you, you will first need to Register on the website. It is a very straight forward process. If a registration was done for you, please make sure to complete your registration form. We need this information for reporting learner information, particularly for anyone requesting ACPE credit.

Step 1

Navigate to the active programs and click on the Green numeral under the “Programs Available” button

Dashboard

This page serves as your account dashboard. From here, you can access the educational content and the corresponding evaluations, track your progress, and make any necessary changes to your profile.

In the boxes below, you will see the items you have completed as well as those you may still access for CME/CE credit. You can only receive credit once for each educational program activity. Please click on a green numbered hyperlink to view the educational activities you have completed or still have available.

Once you have viewed the educational content or participated in a patient simulation, you should then complete the corresponding Evaluation and Request for Credit for that program activity. You will only be able to complete each Evaluation and Request for Credit once and then it will be disabled.

Once you have completed the evaluation form, you will receive a CME certificate via e-mail UNLESS you are requesting ACPE credit. If that is the case, we will enter your NABP information into the database and your CE credit should be available within 30 days. All non-pharmacist participants will receive an ACCME certificate.

If you are a nurse, PA, NP or other specialty, you will need to submit the ACCME certificate to your state board for credit.

Step 2

Scroll to the program you participated in and click on the Green title of the Program

Step 3

Step 4

Step 7

Step 8

You should be redirected to your “dashboard” and now see a message at the top of your screen indicating “Survey Completed Successfully!”. Scroll down to the activity listing for the Evaluation you just completed and you will see a button for
